

Terms and Conditions

1. All information detailing how to enter the “Fantastic Fictions” project forms part of these Terms and Conditions. It is a condition of entry that all rules are accepted as final and that the parent/guardian of the entrant agrees to abide by these rules.
2. Submissions open on 1st October 2020.
3. Closing date for submissions 31st October 2020. Submissions received after this date will not be accepted.
4. Submissions are based on the creation of a piece of writing that does not exceed 500 words or a piece of artwork.
5. All written work accompanying the submission must be the work of the individual making the submission. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian of the entrant to ensure that any content that they submit does not infringe the copyright of any third party or any laws.
6. Copyright of submissions remains with the entrant.
7. Fighting Words will not sell or profit from the entrants’ work.
8. Any submissions with references to nudity, racism, drug use, extreme profanity or other objectionable content will be rejected and excluded.
9. For all applicants, copyright of the creative work will remain with the entrant, however Fighting Words NI together with its partner, Libraries NI (and the Department for Communities), and funders will be granted permission by the parent/guardian of entrants to worldwide, irrevocable and perpetual licence to feature the creative work in any of their publications, promotional material and websites.
10. Events may occur that render the “Fantastic Fictions” project impossible due to reasons beyond the control of Fighting Words NI and the entrants and the parents/guardians of all entrants agree that no liability shall attach to Fighting Words NI or partners as a result.
11. By entering creative work to "Fantastic Fictions", entrants agree to the collection, retention, usage and distribution of their personal information to process and contact them about their submission and for the purposes outlined in these Terms and Conditions.

Fighting Words NI or Libraries NI may pass entrants’ details to third parties and/or otherwise engage third party providers in connection with "Fantastic Fictions" where the third party is acting on Fighting Words NI or Libraries NI’s behalf for the purposes of administrating this project and/or subsequent publicity, and/or as otherwise required by law.
